





Travelling by road:

From the North:

Leave the A1(M) at junction 14, to join the A14 (signposted A14 London (E), Huntingdon, Cambridge, Stansted). Continue along the A14 until junction 33 where you leave to join the A10 (take the 1st exit at the roundabout, signposted Ely). Continue along the A10, taking the second exit at the next three roundabouts towards Ely. At the first roundabout in Ely take the 3rd exit onto the A142 (signposted Soham, Newmarket), continue down the hill with the Cathedral and golf course on your left. Cambridgeshire Business Park is on the right hand side, Bartholomew's Walk is the first left on entering the park and IT Governance is down the end of the road on the right.

From the South:

Leave the M11 at junction 9, branching left to join the A11 (signposted Newmarket, Norwich). Continue forward, then merge onto the A14. Leave the A14 at junction 37 at Newmarket, turning left onto the A142 (signposted Ely). At roundabout take the 1st exit onto A142 Fordham Bypass (signposted Ely). At roundabout take the 2nd exit to continue along A142 Fordham Bypass (signposted Ely). At the Soham roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A142 Soham bypass (signposted Ely). At the roundabout take the 2nd exit and continue forward into Ely, going under the railway crossing. Take the 1st left and go past Tesco on your left hand side. Take the 2nd exit at the Tesco roundabout and Cambridgeshire Business Park is on the left hand side. Bartholomew's Walk is the first left on entering the park and IT Governance is down the end of the road on the right.

Travelling by rail:

Ely is easily accessible by train, with direct rail services from London King's Cross (65 mins) Norwich (60 minutes) Peterborough (40 mins) Birmingham (2½ hours) Manchester (3½ hours) and Stansted airport (50 minutes).

Direct trains from London King's Cross to Ely depart at approximately 45 minutes past each hour. On the departures board these trains are signed 'Cambridge and King's Lynn.'

The office is an easy 5 minute walk from Ely station (footpath marked in red on inset map).

Exit the railway station and walk out of the car park towards Tesco, going past the shop and continue around the building and out of the car park towards the Petrol station and main road. At the roundabout continue with the petrol station on your left and carry along the path until you reach a small cutting to the left, next to Jewson. Take this path and at the end you reach Clive Court. IT Governance is located in Unit 3, on your left in the corner of the courtyard.

Travelling by air:

The nearest airport to Ely is **Stansted Airport**. There is an hourly direct train service from Stansted Airport to Ely which takes 50 minutes.

If arriving at **Heathrow Airport**, your train journey to Ely will take approximately 2 hours 20 minutes. You need to catch an underground train (Piccadilly line, taking 60 minutes) to London King's Cross station, then catch a train from King's Cross to Ely, either the hourly service to King's Lynn via Ely (65 minutes) or a twice-hourly service to Cambridge (50 minutes), where you can then catch a connecting train to Ely (15 minutes).

If arriving at **Gatwick Airport**, it's best to try to catch one of the trains running every 20 minutes from Gatwick (platform 4) to London St Pancras, a direct journey lasting 40 minutes and avoiding the extra time and complication of using the tube. When you get to London St Pancras, just cross over the road to London King's Cross station where you continue your journey (see below). There are also trains leaving every 10 minutes from Gatwick to London Victoria (30 minutes) where you catch a tube train (Victoria line) to London King's Cross (about 25 minutes). From London King's Cross there is an hourly direct service to King's Lynn via Ely (65 minutes) or a twice-hourly service to Cambridge (50 minutes) where you can catch a connecting train to Ely (15 minutes).
